the empty bin to you



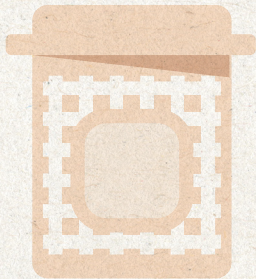
Take the bin back inside. It

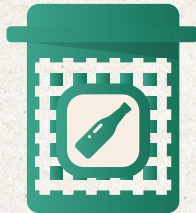

A ventilated bin for indoor use in the kitchen, intended for disposing of organic waste (food scraps and small garden remains). When it's time to take out the organic matter for collection, you need to place this sealed bag inside the multi-compartment bin.

2

A multi-compartment bin to facilitate the disposal of all waste on the street according to the waste collection schedule.

3

A green bin designated for glass disposal on the street as per the waste collection schedule.

4

A magnet featuring the waste collection schedule, detailing the waste permissible for disposal on the street each day and the time frame for placing the multi-stream bin at the house's entrance.



What waste goes in the **ORGANIC MATTER STREAM?**



Fish, shellfish and
shell waste



Meat waste



Cooked food
waste



Fruit waste



Vegetable waste



Plant waste
(small amounts)



Coffee grounds
and tea bags



Kitchen paper and
paper napkins

At home, place organic matter in a compostable bag in the aerated bin. Place this organic matter in the compostable bag in the brown waste container you will find in the closed waste collection points.

Not accepted:

- × Liquid food stuffs
- × Sweeping dust
- × Polystyrene trays, aluminium foil and plastic packaging
- × Cigarette ends and ash
- × Any type of oil
- × Coffee capsules (aluminium or plastic)

What waste goes in the **LIGHTWEIGHT PACKAGING STREAM?**

Not accepted:

- × Full containers
- × Water hoses
- × Hard plastic objects
- × Toys
- × Paper and cardboard
- × Glass containers
- × Coffee capsules
- × Organic matter

Empty containers with liquids or organic matter. Place compacted waste in the yellow found at waste collection points without a bag.



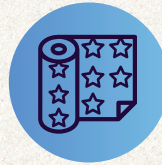
What waste goes in the **PAPER AND CARDBOARD STREAM?**



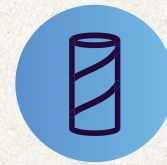
Properly dismantled

Paper bags

Not accepted:

- × Aluminium foil
- × Very dirty paper and cardboard
- × Ceramic cups and dishes
- × Laminated paper
- × Tetra-packs for milk, juice...

Dismantle or cut apart cardboard boxes so they are properly folded and place paper and cardboard without a bag in the blue containers found at waste collection points.

What waste goes in the **GLASS STREAM?**



Glass bottles



Perfume bottles



Glass jars

Not accepted:

- × Panels of glass
- × Mirrors
- × Cups, mugs, glasses, dishes
- × Fluorescent lights
- × Light bulbs
- × Lids

Before throwing away, empty glass containers of liquids and organic matter and remove lids. Place the glass containers in the green bin.



What waste goes in the **OTHER STREAM?**



Very dirty paper
and cardboard



Wipes,
gauzes, bandages



Sweeping dust,
ash, hair



Razors



Ceramics and
porcelain
(small items)

Be sure that this waste is not apt for recycling. Place it in a well-sealed bag in the multi-stream bin.



SANITARY TEXTILES:

Nappies, sanitary napkins, tampons

*In case of generating sanitary textile and animal excrement, place this bag properly sealed on top of the multifraction bin. **This stream can be taken outside in a separate bag each day of the week.***

Not accepted:

- × Bulky items
- × Hazardous waste
- × Paper and cardboard, glass, lightweight packaging
- × Organic matter
- × Batteries
- × Medicine
- × Lids
